- Why AAP: Chadha's perspective on the AAP as a movement rather than a conventional political party highlighted the importance of focusing on governance and public welfare. He reiterated the party's willingness to entrust young individuals from diverse backgrounds with significant roles

in policymaking. He remarked that AAP is not just a political party but the fastest growing and most successful political startup in India – highlighting the party's focus on innovation!

- Youth in Politics: Raghav Chadha highlighted that although India is a young nation, but our leaders are old. The average age of Indians is 29 but the average age of MPs in 17th Lok Sabha (17th LS) is 54. Only 1.5% of MPs under 30 in 17th LS in India, compared to 13.6% in Norway. He shed light on the challenges faced by young individuals entering politics These challenges included limited platforms for youth to influence policy, nepotism, stereotypes about youth's capabilities, and the established hierarchies within political parties.
- Promoting Youth: As an MLA, Raghav Chadha instituted the Youth With Raghav Fellowship to provide a platform for youth in his constituency to support governance initiatives in their area. The program's fellows played a crucial role in addressina real-time public grievances through dedicated helpline, especially during the pandemic. Their efforts included arranging hospital beds, calling ambulances, facilitating oxygen cylinder refills, and ensuring doorstep ration deliveries. What began as a local initiative in the assembly transformed into a statewide effort, led by 40 dedicated youth volunteers who assisted over 15,000 patients with hospital admissions, oxygen cylinders, and counseling. This experience highlighted the transformative impact of involving youth in politics and the immense potential they hold in catalyzing positive change.
- Message for Youth: Raghav Chadha's message for the youth was clear: get involved and shape India's future. His call to action for the youth to actively participate in shaping India's future resonated with me. His vision of a progressive, inclusive, and prosperous India inspired me to consider public service as a medium for bringing about positive change.

- Suspension from Parliament: His suspension from Parliament for voicing his concerns against the Delhi Services Act reinforced the challenges and risks associated with standing up for principles and the rights of the citizens. His determination to approach the Supreme Court to uphold parliamentary procedures and democratic norms was a powerful testament to his commitment to upholding democracy.
- Formation of INDIA Alliance: Raghav Chadha's involvement in the INDIA alliance highlighted the importance of building alliances to address pressing issues facing the country. His critique of the government's focus on vendetta politics over addressing critical challenges emphasized the role of the opposition in holding the government accountable.

My day shadowing Raghav Chadha offered invaluable insights into the multifaceted role of a Member of Parliament and the dedication required to serve the nation.
